\* EDRD 620: Reading in the Middle and Secondary School (3) (This course is required for middle level and secondary teachers, but is not part of the 18 hours of the endorsement covered by the grant. If teachers have not taken this course, they need to take it and transfer the credits in at their own expense.)

Teachers in the program must also take the ESL: PLACE Exam to be eligible for licensure in Colorado. The cost of the PLACE exam is not covered by the grant.

By federal regulation, teachers receiving tuition scholarships must work in a high need school district (all participating school districts are considered high need) for at least the length of time they received the scholarship. In addition, teachers who do not complete the endorsement may have to pay back the tuition received, unless extenuating circumstances prevail.
